# **Macmillan Coffee Morning**

We will be holding our annual Macmillan Coffee Morning, and we would like to invite you to our event at Scissett Middle School from 8:00 to 8:45am in the school hall. There will be cakes/buns, biscuits, tea and coffee on sale.

#### Attention All Bakers!

We would be very grateful if pupils/parents would bake/buy something to donate that we can sell that morning. If you can help, please can we ask that pupils bring these to the school office on Thursday 25 September to help raise funds for a worthwhile cause. Tea and coffee will be also served. The bake sale will have a 'European Theme' and pupils will be given ideas in form time over the next two weeks.

Please can we remind you that any baking/bought goods should not contain nuts or sesame seeds as we have pupils with severe allergies to these items. Where possible, we would be very grateful if you could provide an ingredient list with any baked goods.

Payment for the cakes, tea and coffee will be in form of a donation. You/your child will need the correct amount you are happy to donate as there will not be change available.

## **European Day of Languages**

As this day is also the European Day of Languages, we are asking pupils are to wear non-uniform that is both practical for sports and linked to the theme of 'European Day of Languages.' Again, any funds raised will go to Macmillan Cancer Support.
