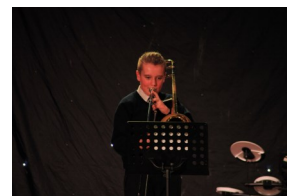
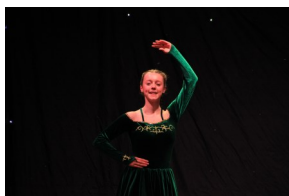
Care Home Visits
