#### **English**

During this short half term, the children will have lots of opportunities to demonstrate the writing skills they have acquired this year because we will be completing a number of short units of work studying books that we then adapt to produce our own stories. These will include writing instructions, diaries and stories. Guided reading will focus on comprehension skills and in phonics we will continue to practise the spelling patterns and common exception words for Year 2. There will be daily handwriting practice as well. Grammar lessons will focus on punctuation, the different types of sentences and contracted

#### Maths

This will be a packed half term as we still have to complete our work on time before we do some consolidation of what we have learnt so far. We will continue with our 'Speedy Maths' and 'Times Tables' sheets but on Thursdays rather than on Fridays. The sheets completed in class will be sent home with the children on Friday, mainly to allow more time for marking them! These sheets will give you a good indication of the type of practice with adding and taking away as well as times tables that it would be beneficial for you to do with your child.

# Science
