English

During this half term, the children will continue to have lots of opportunities to demonstrate the writing skills they have acquired this year. We will complete units of work studying books that we then adapt to produce our own instructions and diaries. Guided reading will be taught as a whole class as preparation for the transition to KS2. In phonics we will continue to practise the spelling patterns and common exception words for Year 2. There will be daily handwriting practice as well. Grammar lessons will focus on punctuation, the different types of sentences and contracted words.

Maths

We will be consolidating the maths we have learnt in KS1. We will be tackling tricky word problem and completing some challenging investigations. We will recommence our 'Speedy Maths' and 'Times Tables' sheets on Thursdays. As before the sheets completed in class will be sent home with the children on Friday. These sheets will give you a good indication of the type of practice with adding and taking away as well as times tables that it would be beneficial for you to do with your child.
