<u>English</u>

We will first be recapping the previous year's learning to establish some non-negotiables for the year. Following that, we will be reading Billy and the Minpins. In this unit of work, we will learn about word choices and trying to improve our vocabulary when describing settings and characters. We will finish by writing a sequel. Then, we will read the story The First Drawing which will link to our Stone Age work. We will do lots of work in role in this unit and write our own prehistoric story. After half term, we will be reading and writing humorous poems on the topic of school.

Maths

We will be working with numbers up to 1000 and making sure we have a secure understanding of the value of hundreds numbers. We will move on to calculating with two digits first and then three digit numbers. We will learn to use mental and written methods. After half term, we will be concentrating on written and mental multiplication and division. We will recap how to multiply and divide and the 2 and 5 times table. We will then moving on to learning the 3, 4 and 8 times table.

<u>R.E.</u>

Miss Flynn will teach R.E. on a Thursday afternoon. Our first topic considers what it means to be 'Called by God' and after half term we will be reflecting upon Christmas including how 'God is with us' Year 3 Autumn Term How did we get here?

<u>History</u>

We will be learning how life changed in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will look at the houses prehistoric people lived in, how they changed from hunter-gatherers to farmers and will learn about Stonehenge.

Geography

After half term, we will be learning about mountains and volcanoes. We will use maps and atlases to find where some they are in the world and we will learn the different types of each and how they are formed.

<u>Science</u>

We will start the term thinking about our own health and learning about the body. We will explore what is needed for a healthy balanced diet. After half term, we will be exploring rocks and soils. We will spend time naming and exploring rocks including investigating their properties before looking at different types of soil. We will also learn about the fossilisation process.

Art/D.T.

We will be investigating and making sandwiches. This will link with our nutrition work in Science. After half term, we will be looking at sculptures with an emphasis on the work of Eva Rothschild.

Computing

First, we will be focusing on Online Safety and learning skills to be a safe and responsible digital citizen. After half term, we will be exploring the difference between the internet and the World Wide Web.

PSHE

We will focus on health and well-being this term including discussing what positively and negatively affects our physical, mental and emotional health.

<u>Р.Е.</u>

We start the year with a recap of the fundamental movement skills - running, hopping, skipping, jumping and rolling/bouncing/kicking/throwing a ball - before moving on to apply these skills in a variety of small team games.
