English

In guided reading, we will continue to read Odd and the Frost Giants. This term, we will also be reading, acting out and writing playscripts as well as focusing on persuasive writing including making our own adverts and taking part in class debates. The children will be completing writing tasks based on the books written by David Walliams. In SPAG, we will be trying to incorporate commas to separate clauses in complex sentences and use apostrophes correctly. Our spellings will continue to focus on the Lower KS2 lists this term.

Maths

We will continue to focus on the Times Tables from 1-12 and will be encouraging the children to use the computer programs 'Hit the Button' and 'Times Tables Rock Stars' to support this. The children will be working with decimals and fractions. They will also be using the inverse methods for checking one and two step word problems. We will be converting between different units of measure, including length, mass, time and money. The children will also be writing amounts of money using decimal notation.

R.E.

This term the children will be completing a unit called Jesus the Son of God. We will then move on to studying Islam, focussing on the mosque and comparing it to a Christian church.

<u>Science</u>

We will be learning about solids, liquids and gases and their properties. The children will be completing lots of experiments linked to solids and liquids including heating and cooling different materials. We will also be investigating which materials are good thermal insulators and look at sieving, dissolving and filtering to separate solids.
