English

This term will begin with revision our grammar and punctuation knowledge in preparation for the SATs. We will also be working on our reading comprehension skills.

Following SATs we will begin our work on a Shakespeare play – the title of which will be revealed at a later date........ We will be doing lots of drama activities as we prepare to put on our very own production of the play at the end of term. Much of our writing this term will be based on the chosen play, as well as writing linked to our topic of "Mountains".

Maths

In maths we will begin with revision of all topics in the lead up to SATs. We will focus particularly on data handing (including calculating the mean average), time (including reading timetables), reading scales and converting between units of measure. This will be followed by more investigative maths activities.

R.E.

We will be moving on from Easter in R.E. by looking at Jesus' ascension and what happened at Pentecost. We will then be considering ideas about God.

Key Vocabulary

Geography: plate tectonics, types of mountains, vocabulary associated with volcanoes, OS map symbols

Science: reversible / irreversible change, soluble, insoluble, solvent, saturated solution

Science

We will begin by investigating the process of dissolving then move on to look at reversible and irreversible changes. Our final science topic will be light, finding out about how light travels and how we see things.

DT

We will be using cams, gears and pulleys to design and create our own moving toys

Geography

We will be investigating mountain ranges around the world and how mountains are formed, including volcanoes. We will learn about some of the mountains in the Lake District, whilst becoming familiar with ordnance survey maps.

PE

We will be developing a range of athletics skills in preparation for sports day. We will be going swimming each Thursday after the half term break, where we will focus on water safety and rescue skills. The whole class will also be taking part in the School Sports Festival at Salt Ayre Sports Centre at the end of May, taking part in a wide range of sporting events and competitions.

Computing

We will continue to practise our coding skills, using a variety of coding languages. Following this, we will be looking at different computer networks, including the internet.

PSHE

In PSHE our focus will be on how we contribute to the wider world. Much of our work will take place during Year 6's "Citizenship Week", when we find out about national and local government, our responsibilities within society and the rule of law. This will include a visit from the Police and a trip to the Magistrate's Court for a mock trial. We will also learn about managing money and undertake a first aid course.
