Reminders

<u>Parking:</u> Please do not park on the zig zag lines at the crossing or on double yellow lines (which is illegal) or on corners. Doing so makes it very dangerous for both children and parents to cross.

<u>Hair:</u> Any child with long hair should have it tied back neatly away from their face.

Earrings: Despite the reminder last week some children are still wearing earrings. These must be removed before coming to school otherwise children will miss PE and possibly playing outside.

<u>One-Way System:</u> Thank you to those parents who remember to enter and leave school via the one say system which is to come in at the main gate by the office and leave via the car park. This prevents a bottleneck by the main gate.

<u>Belongings:</u> It has been noted that some parents are still not naming their child's belongings. This makes it extremely difficult to reunite lost property. If you don't want to lose it—CLEARLY NAME IT.

<u>Dinner Money:</u> Please ensure if you have to pay for school dinners you do so in advance— £2.60/day. We will contact anyone with an outstanding balance.
