Absence

School Dinners

School dinners are still being provided with a choice of 3 hot meals daily. However, the choices on a given day may not be as shown in the lunch menu. This is because kitchen staff ordered food on the basis of all children being in school and having the menu for the first few weeks. As we can only have smaller number of children in school, the freezer is still quite full and the kitchen staff are understandably using this before reordering. We are trying to keep as near the menu as possible and would appreciate your understanding if it does differ slightly. Many thanks.

Dinner Money

Over the next week or so we will be contacting anyone with an outstanding dinner money balance. The aim is to clear all balances before school eventually reopens for all children (hopefully not too long off!). If you do not already have a Scopay account which enables on-line payments, please contact the office and we can provide the details.

Free School Meal Vouchers

If you receive FSM vouchers from school but your child attends on a part-time basis and has a school meal, THIS MUST BE PAID FOR otherwise your child will be getting the equivalent of 2 free meals. For example, if your child has a packed lunch Monday to Thursday and a school meal on Friday, you must send in £2.30 to pay for the meal as you have already received this in your weekly vouchers.
