# **COVID Track and Trace Over Half Term**

Just a reminder that should your child develop any symptoms and then test positive for covid within **2 days of them leaving school today**, i.e. before end of Sunday, YOU MUST INFORM MRS AYLOTT IMMEDIATELY via email (head@scotforth-st-pauls.lancs.sch.uk) as parents of children in that particular class bubble would have to be notified they must self-isolate for 10 days as close contacts.

Year 4—please could Y4 parents be especially vigilant over the next couple of days, as 3 children have been sent home ill in the last 2 days (but no covid results at the moment). Should your child develop any symptoms, please follow the above advice regarding testing as this may have implications for the rest of the children/families in Y4 over the half-term break.
