### Y2 Lunch Reminder

A reminder to Y2 parents that when they return in September to Y3, they will no longer be entitled to a free school meal, as this only applies to KS1 children and those who qualify for free school meals\*. If you would like your child to have a hot school dinner, please ensure this is paid for in advance, £2.35 per day. This can be daily, weekly (£11.75 weekly), half-termly (£82.25) or termly (£164.50). This can be cash, cheque or via Scopay. If you are not already registered with Scopay, please ask at the office and we can provide the details for you.

\* Form to apply for FSM attached if you think you may be eligible.

### Dinner Money

Please can parents ensure that their child's dinner money is paid up to date by the end of term and that ALL balances are cleared. Reminders will be sent out before the end of term, regardless of the amount owing. Thank you.
