KS1 Christmas Production

Following the item in last week's newsletter, we have today taken the difficult decision that we will be filming this year's KS1 nativity play, rather than increasing the Covid risk to our families and staff by inviting parents into school to watch it live. We appreciate some may be disappointed by this decision, but we have to be mindful of the health and safety of all our children, staff and families as we approach the Christmas period.

We will be posting the play on the school website, within a password protected area. Parents will be issued with the password via text and will be able to view the video for the duration of the Christmas holidays. We would ask you to respect our usual safeguarding request by not sharing the video on social media. If anyone has any skills in filming/video editing and would be able to help us with this, please let the office know.

In consultation with Rev. Rebecca, we are planning to hold a carol service for the children in church at the end of term. This will be the first time that the whole school will have gathered together indoors since the start of the pandemic, so a very significant moment. However, to allow distancing between classes and again, avoid overcrowding and the increased risk of Covid transmission, we will not be inviting parents to join us on this occasion.
