#### Reminders

One Way System: Please remember that there is a one-way system in the morning— Y1 have their own waiting area at the front of school, everyone else should come in via the main gate by the office and leave via the car park. Water Bottles: These should be clear with water, not

juice, and clearly named.

Earrings: There should be no child wearing earrings due to safety reasons. Please ensure they are removed before coming to school otherwise they will have to sit out of PE. Hair: Any child with long hair should have it tied back whilst in school.

<u>Nuts & Kiwi</u>: Please remember we are a nut and kiwi free school—this includes any spreads that contain nuts.

<u>Dinner Money:</u> £2.60 per day and should be paid in advance.

<u>Absence:</u> You must let school know before 9.30am if your child will not be attending school. The office is open from 8am or you can leave a voice mail on the telephone. You can also email school, preferably the office rather than the class teacher.

**NAME BELONGINGS:** Possibly the most important thing to do if you want your child's belongings returned.

#### Contact Information

It is important to keep school informed of any changes in your contact details. If you have changed phone number, email address or made any other changes to your details, please let school know immediately. If we are not updated, you may miss out on important information or we may not be able to contact you in an emergency.

### Photographs (15th Oct)

There will be the opportunity for siblings in school to have their photographs taken together during the day. If, however, anyone has a sibling **NOT** in school or a nursery child who does not come on a Tuesday and you would like to have their photo taken, the photographer will be here from 8.30-9.00am to take family photos.
