As in the previous term, the children will have quizzes on Purple Mash to practice spellings. This half term, we will be focusing on the statutory Year 3 spellings. These are very quick quizzes and will reinforce the learning we are doing in class.

We will also be focusing on improving our times table knowledge. Any practise of the 2,3,4,5 and 8 times tables will be extremely beneficial as they are expected to be able to recall a times table fact without having to count.

PE kit and school uniform should be named and in school on the first day of every term. P.E. lessons will be taking place on a Tuesday and Wednesday this term.
