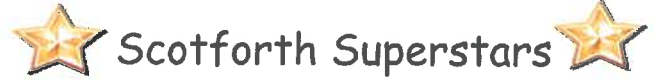

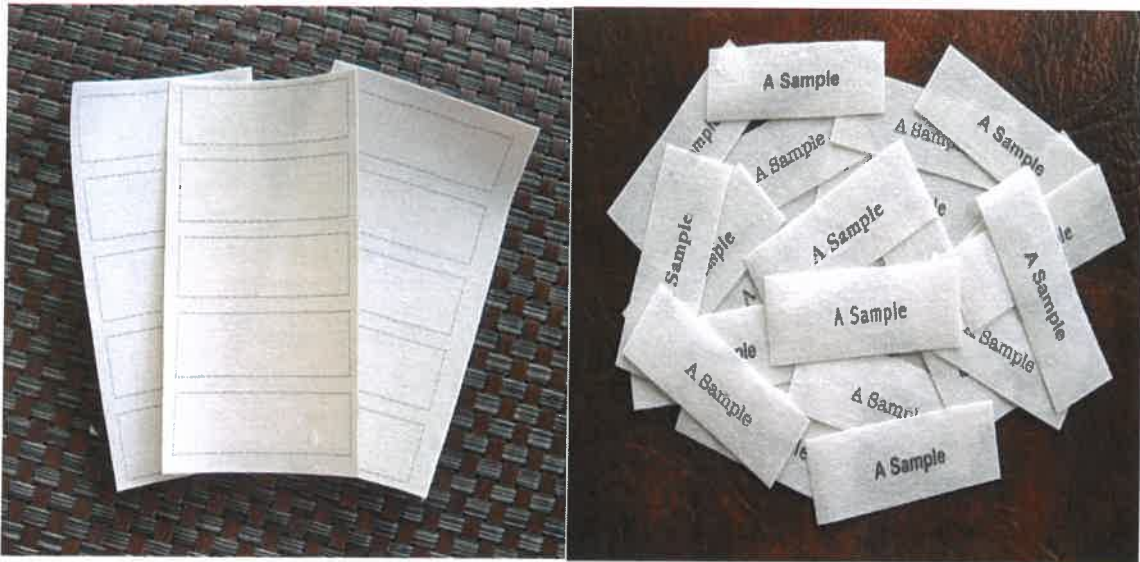
Friends of Dorrington Wood
