7. There is no limit to the number of entries per school.

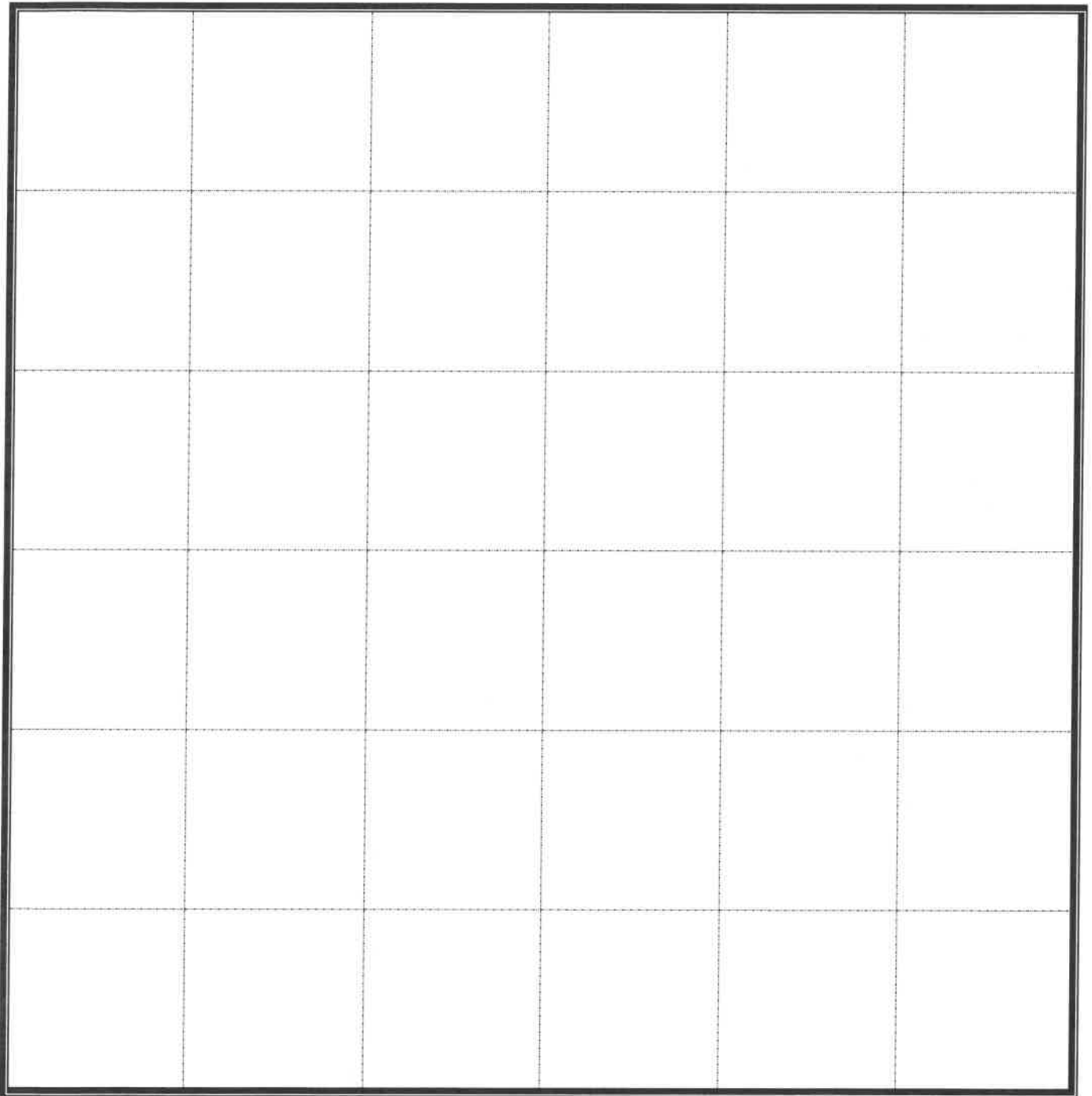
