Subject: Anti social behaviour

Hi

Since the beginning of the first lockdown, we have noticed an increase in anti-social behaviour across our parks and open spaces.

We met with the police last month who advised the more its reported the more resources they can put into it.

We understand that people think they shouldn't bother the police with these types of issues and it can be seen as wasting police time.

However, without this evidence, they are unable to target it.

The police have asked if you ever witness ASB, it can be reported in the following ways:

You can also ring 101 or if they are causing damage to property they should ring 999, as that a criminal offence.

The police said they normally start going into schools around about now educating kids on behaviours etc but currently cant due to COVID, so they are going to send something to the schools so that they can do it instead.

As well as an increase in ASB, we have been hearing that Community Centres are struggling to engage with young people. We are going to meet with youth workers to discuss the ASB that has been taking place and engagement opportunities going forward.

To help with this, if you know of any ASB that has been happening in your park / open space this year, please could you send me a description as we are trying to get all the evidence together. I will not share your details, this will be kept confidential.
