Communication and Language

<u>Understanding the world-</u>We will explore toys including those with light/sound and moving parts. We will try to use a range of describing words to talk about our toys. We will make a pop up toy. We will test bath toys and see which sink/float. We will join in with special times, first counting down during advent and then taking part in our Nativity and Christmas party.

Expressive Arts and Design-We will make up stories and illustrate with pictures/models and through dance. We will learn new themed songs linked to Winter and Christmas.

<u>Literacy-</u>We will write invitations and cards-giving meaning to our marks. We will all try and write at least the first letter of our names. We will share stories in small and larger groups. The book area will keep a few familiar favourites from last half term and then lots of new books. We will have Christmas and winter themed fiction and non-fiction around the room.

<u>Maths-</u>We will look at numbers on the advent calendar and count up and back to 10 and 20. We will name 2d shapes and start to look at patterns. We will make our own wrapping paper to wrap surprise gifts. We will talk about more/less and more/fewer.

<u>Wider Curriculum</u> This half term we will be meeting junior doctors and taking them our sick teddies. We will look at toys we like and what a baby might like and how this is similar/different.

<u>Values</u> Our value this half term is hope. Our Nursery rules are "Kind words, kind, hands, kind feet."
