Welcome to school or Welcome back! This half term we welcome Sanchia, Ashton, Leo, Emily, Matteo and Angela.

This half term our topic is "growing." We will be looking at non-fiction books as well as stories including "Jack and the beanstalk" and "Jaspers beanstalk."

We continue to have our kind hands board and will write children's names on it to celebrate their kindness. We are encouraging children to name their emotions and also recognise that their actions have an effect on others.

Week one is going to be all about eggs! We hope to have a friendly hen visit and will think of lots of other creatures that lay eggs. We will use some of the hen's eggs to bake cakes. Now that the children have experienced Easter in different ways we will be talking about what we now know. On Thursday there is a family Easter Hunt around Dorrington Road Woods. Later in the half term we will celebrate the end of Ramadan.

We will be going outside regularly. We have wellies the children can borrow but we may get dirty/wet so a spare change of clothes is handy.
