



Operation Encompass

There have been no procedures within Lancashire for reporting Domestic Abuse incidents to schools, which means that our children are left without the support and nurture that they need when they need it most. Operation Encompass has now been created to address this, so that by 9.00am on the next school day the school's "Key Adult" will be informed that the child or young person has been involved, heard or witnessed a domestic incident.

This knowledge, given to schools through Operation Encompass, allows the provision of immediate early intervention through silent, or overt support dependent upon the needs and wishes of the child. Here at Scotforth St Paul's, the "Key Adult" is the Headteacher/Designated Safeguarding Lead.
