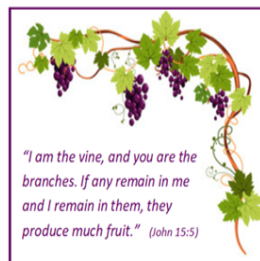

Dear Parents,

Our Parents' afternoon/evening of the year will be held on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2022 between 1.15 p.m. – 3.00 p.m. and 3.30 p.m. – 6.30 p.m. in the School Hall. Parents should report to the hall and sign in. It is a "Parent and Child Consultation" session with the teacher.

At Scotforth we encourage our children to take responsibility for their learning, sharing targets and so on and Parent/Child consultation is part of that process. As in previous years, we can offer the option for children (Year 2 and above only) to come and hear the discussions with you for the first half of the appointment only as we know that there may also be some discussions best held just between adults and teachers. The choice of whether to see the teacher completely on your own, or with your child is up to you. Your child will return to class if in the daytime and to the ICT suite if in the evening, until your appointment slot is over. Please clearly indicate a **first, second and third preferred time slot** on the return slip and please also indicate if you would like your child to attend. Where a first, second and third slot is not indicated you may be allocated any available time. Where there is more than one child in a family we will endeavour to give reasonably concurrent appointment times. As normal, appointments will last **eight minutes**. If you feel after the appointment, you need more time, please contact the class teacher the next day. Please return a form for each child to their class teacher by **Monday 10<sup>th</sup> October** at the latest. We will endeavour to allocate appointments after the return deadline but cannot guarantee this. Appointments will be sent out on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> October. If you are unable to attend, please email the class teacher to arrange a mutually convenient Zoom appointment.

Remember, if you ever have a concern, please don't wait until parents' evening, but pop in and see us so that we can help. Thank you, and we look forward to meeting with you on the 19<sup>th</sup> October.
