

Literacy

We will continue to complete daily phonics and handwriting lessons. We will concentrate on blending and writing words that contain alternative sounds. We will consolidate reading and writing the tricky words we have learnt so far. There will be lots of opportunities to write independently. We will continue to focus on a book each week and look at the characters and events in the story.

Mathematics

We will focus on doubling, sharing and grouping and odd and even numbers,. We will revisit spatial reasoning, matching rotating and manipulating structures and later composing and decomposing structures. Later in the half term we will look again at patterns and relationships. The children will be given lots of opportunities to explore and investigate relationships between numbers and shape.

We will learn about the stories Jesus would have heard as a child and later in the half-term the stories Jesus told.

Physical

During PE sessions we will continue to focus on the fundamental movements of running, jumping, rolling, throwing and catching. We will continue to work on our pencil grip and control by building up our hand strength with activities such as dough disco, threading and lacing, junk modelling and cutting out.

P.S.E.D

We will continue to talk about kind words, kind hands and kind feet. This will be reinforced during circle time and PSHE lessons. We will learn about seasons and revisit animal and plant life cycles. We will be talking about growing and changing; naming body parts and what parts of our body are private.

Communication and Language

We will talk about journeys we have made. We will retell the stories we read, develop our language through role-play and small world play and continue to work on recognising rhyming words. We will learn about story structure through sequencing stories using props and learn about main characters through making and playing with puppets.

Understanding the world

Through our Journeys topic we will look at places we can walk to, what kind of transport we might find - on roads, - on or under the water, and - in the air. We will walk to the 'field', following a map and explore a small wooded area on the way.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will continue to learn songs during our music lessons and actions to accompany the words. We will experiment with different colours and art mediums and make props and puppets to recreate the stories we are reading.
