Welcome back to this our last term in Reception! I hope you had a relaxing Easter break and made the most of the good weather.

The children have all settled back into school well and are working incredibly hard. This term our topics are: 'Growth and Change' and in the second half 'Journeys and Moving on'. As well as growing plants we will learn about some mammal, bird, insect and plant lifecycles in the first half of the term.

PE- our PE days are Mondays and Thursdays, taught by Mrs Browne. You have all been brilliant at ensuring your child has their kit in school and that all items are clearly labelled with their names - thank you very much.

Please continue to help your child at home by regularly hearing them read. We would like you to read to your child, or hear them read to you every night for a few minutes please, as this really helps their skills develop. Doing calculations 'in their heads' is also very valuable e.g. number facts up to 5 or 10 and counting forwards and backwards starting from any number up to 20.

To tie in better with our topic, I have swapped the unit in PSHE to 'Growing and Changing'. This unit covers the naming of body parts and the differences between boys and girls. Should you want any further information let me know.
