

Literacy

We will continue to complete daily phonics and handwriting lessons. We will concentrate on blending sounds and writing words by segmenting the sounds we hear. We will read 'Kipper's Toy box' and 'Harry and the Robots.' We will read instructions to make a toy and try to write our own. We will make some toys in the construction area and write labels for toys we have made.

Mathematical

We will focus on numbers to 20; counting reliably to 20, recognising numbers to 20, finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number and matching quantities to written numerals. We will use 2d/3d shapes to make a robot using big boxes and smaller boxes. We will number instructions in the correct order and reorder numbers which are out of order.

R.E.

We will learn about friendship by talking about what makes a good friend and thinking about Jesus as our friend. We will find out about the nativity story by exploring births and birthdays. We will also learn about the Festival of Light.

Physical

During PE sessions we will continue to focus on the fundamental movements of running, jumping, rolling, throwing and catching. We will continue to work on our pencil grip and control by building up our hand strength with activities such as lacing and threading, playdough letter making, creating collages and cutting out and dressing Santa.

P.S.E.D

We will continue to talk about kind words, kind hands and kind feet. We will learn about caring about our toys and ourselves during the Teddy Bear hospital visits. This will be reinforced during keyworker time and we will talk about caring for each other as well.

Communication and Language

We will talk about any celebrations such as birthdays or parties that the children have experienced. To encourage the children to ask questions we will play 'Who's in the Box'? We will make a puppet theatre to act out some of the stories we have read and the stories the children have made up.

Understanding the world

We will find out more about all sorts of toys including mechanical toys and toys from the past. We will encourage the children to make connections between small world toys and the real world using this as a springboard for them to talk about their own experiences.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be learning the songs for our Christmas play and some actions to accompany the words. We will be making our own toys using junk modelling and construction toys.
