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Dear parents,

I hope you have had a good rest from schoolwork over that lovely sunny half term! This pack is different from the others. It reflects more the day to day pattern of lessons and activities I was planning to teach in school and would like you to follow at home. There are lessons for each day for phonics, maths, literacy and topic.

Maths:

In common with the other year groups in school, please follow the White Rose Home learning lessons. These are maths activities that use stories as the stimulus for reception aged children. You will already be familiar with the website from my previous letters. Please start with the lessons for the summer term week 3 (week commencing 4th May) as these lessons cover patterns, measurement and revision of some areas the children will have covered already at home. Please then complete the lessons for week commencing 11th May in week 2 and the lessons for week commencing 18th May in week3 of the summer 2 half term.

Please start each Maths lesson with counting in ones from different numbers up to 20 and then back down to zero

Please also introduce counting in tens to the children. Please do this in a very similar way to the suggestions on the following video:

I have included a hundreds square in the pack so you can complete the activity in the video with your child.

Phonics:

I would like you to continue to revise all the letter sounds the children have learnt so far. You will have noticed that the letter sounds are introduced in a different order in the DfE phonics lessons to the Jolly Phonics scheme we are following. At home, please follow the DfE phonics lessons. Please start with the following lessons, on a daily basis, in order to cover some sounds the children were not taught prior to school's partial closure in March. This would ensure that all the children can start Year 1 having had the same input:

I will be introducing the reading of these words slowly in school-no more than 2 a day. We will also practice writing the words. I have included a copy of the words so that you could play a matching game with the blue set once you have cut them up.

Literacy:

In common with the other year groups in school, I would like you to follow the LPDS lessons found in your pack. I have split the lessons into days and provided the resources to use each day. I will email you an electronic copy of the sheets to make following the links easier.

Topic:

Our topic for this half term is 'Journeys'.
