In English

In English, we will be looking at stories with familiar settings by discussing the setting, characters and events. We will also be writing a fact book about plants/flowers looking at the features of a non-fiction book e.g. Glossary. We will continue with daily phonic sessions, daily handwriting lessons and weekly S.P.A.G lessons. Your child will read in Independent/guided reading sessions with an adult.

In Maths

This term we will continue to focus on numbers to 50 first recapping on the place value and problem solving, then move to length and weight. We will then look at numbers to 100, place value, addition and subtraction facts and word problems. Please continue working on daily counting and learning number bonds to 10/20.
