In English

In Literacy, we will be finishing off writing our Non-Fiction booklets about plants and looking at the features of Non-Fiction books e.g. contents, glossary, fact boxes etc.

Key Vocabulary

<u>PE-</u>Our P.E days are Mondays and Fridays. We will continue to look at the Fundamental skills through a series of games and athletics.

<u>Computing-</u> We will use imodel to create our own adventure game. We will also be looking at 'Paint' and its tools, to create our own Mondrian pieces.

<u>PSHE-</u> We will continue to discuss correct terminology for body parts, knowing that private parts are private and also discussing keeping safe e.g. road safety, sun safety and keeping our personal details safe.
