Welcome back to the last term of Year 3! We have had a turbulent year so far but we seem to be on the road back to normal and we have some great things to be doing in class this term.

It is very important that the children read every night. Reading diary books should be signed by parents to indicate the page reached each evening and along with the reading book and should be brought into school every day. Guided reading will take place on Fridays where we will all access the same book together and then complete a task based on what we have read.

As in previous terms, the children will have weekly quizzes on Purple Mash to practice the spelling patterns. There will also be regular quizzes on the statutory Year 3 spellings. These are very quick quizzes and will reinforce the learning we are doing in class.

We will also be focusing on improving our times table knowledge. We are currently enjoying these videos on Youtube to help [Counting Songs - YouTube](#). Any practise of the 2,3,4,5 and 8 times tables will be extremely beneficial.

PE kit and school uniform should be named and in school on the first day of every term. P.E. lessons will be taking place on a Wednesday and a Thursday this term.
