Dear parents of all EYFS children,

In the event of school closure we will be sending home a pack of activities that you might like to do with your child. It is very difficult to put a pack together as a lot of time in school is spent developing child's physical, social and communication skills.

All children will receive a dinosaur project book. In this they can draw pictures and write short captions. Reception children should try to write sentences. Nursery children could practice writing letter shapes and their names. Once school returns we will show these books as part of circle time but they will not be formally marked in any way. Reception children could practice letter formation and writing simple words using the sheets and the words provided in the accompanying packs. All children will bring home a reading book that we will need back in school after Easter. All of the books have questions and/or ideas of things you could do.

The ideas below are things you might do with Nursery aged children. Reception aged children need to try and complete as many of them as possible.

Nursery activities at home

We have watched the number blocks up to number block 6-you could watch these programmes at home and keep going up to 10. The free number block app has some simple games on it.

Watch CBeebies-there are lots of programmes e.g. "Hey Duggee" about keeping trying and getting along with others.

Learn some more Nursery rhymes and counting songs. Lots of name writing-especially for children who are going to school in September.

Recognising numbers to 10 and beginning to write them.

Counting and asking children about 1 more/1 less. Talking about the changes outside especially about new life/growth and seasons.

Reception activities at home

We have watched the number blocks up to number block 7-you could watch these programmes at home and keep going up to 10.

Please practice addition and subtraction facts up to 10 using concrete objects.

The free number block app has some simple games on it.

Count from 0 to 20 and from 20 backwards to 0. Also start at different numbers going both forwards and backwards.

Practice recognising numbers up to 20 using the number cards provided in the pack. Practice ordering numbers up to 20 using the number cards provided. Practice finding one more and one less than numbers up to 20 (use the ordered numbers as a number line to help).
