This being said, I will be working through the activities listed with the children who are coming into school so would like to ask those with children coming in on a part time basis to try to stick to the days noted.

Literacy (daily)

Maths (daily)

Wednesday 24 th June	Please share the slideshow that I have sent you via email to introduce our new topic all about 'Travel and Transport'. 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Thursday 25 th June	Please share slideshow number 2 all about trains now and in the past. Draw a Victorian train using images from the slideshow or the internet to help and label it.	
Friday 26 th June	P.E Technology permitting, please choose a couple of activities from https://www.bbc.co.uk/teach/supermovers/ks1-collection/zbr4scw . These are linked to maths, English or PSHE and are a fun way to get your child moving.	
Monday 29 th June	Today we will focus on the invention of cars - slideshow number 3. After discussion, order the cars chronologically and complete the questions on the sheet (3B).	
Tuesday 30 th June	Think about boats today using the art slideshow that I have emailed to you. The last few slides focus upon creating a piece of artwork but if you would rather create an origami boat, I have sent instructions for this instead and you can skip these slides.	
Wednesday 1 st July	The focus today will be aeroplanes – slideshow number 4. Included in your pack is a news report cloze activity with an additional information text. Alternatively, get creative and design your own aeroplane.	
Thursday 2 nd July	Time to get creative again today. Start by looking at hot air balloons using Art slideshow 2. The children are then asked to create their own hot air balloon using papier mache.	
Friday 3 rd July	P.E. – time to get physical again. If the sun is shining why not get outside for a nice long walk or bike ride. If it's not, check out some more of the activities on the supermovers site.	

***For children coming into school please stick to the dates noted. Everyone else can complete the activities in whichever order you prefer.

I hope you enjoy completing some of these activities. Don't forget your child has a subscription to Purple Mash where they can access activities across all areas of the curriculum if they're at a loose end.
