Welcome to the Summer Term in Year 4! We have enjoyed our time with the class so far and are looking forward to a productive term with lots of hard work, learning and fun.

Details of the curriculum we will cover this term are attached with this letter, and are also available on our school website.

Each week the children will continue to do the Speedy Maths Trail and the Times Tables Trail to improve their number fact recall. We have also introduced a 15 minute arithmetic test that will reinforce key areas already taught. Most of the children have been working hard at learning their **multiplication tables**. It is important that the children know the multiplication facts out of order as well as chanting them straight through. It is also good to look at related division facts when learning tables so the children are more able to see the relationship between multiplication and division, e.g. $4 \times 5 = 20$ so $20 \div 4 = 5$ & $20 \div 5 = 4$. Times tables are so important and any help at home with these is beneficial.

We expect the children to **read** regularly at home either to themselves or to an adult or sibling.

P.E. will take place on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays but please ensure that your child has a complete, named P.E. kit in school every day so that we can take advantage of the good weather when possible and be ready for any extra practices we may have for Sports Day.

In June, Year 4 will complete assessments and in early July you will receive your child's report. This will be followed by the annual 'Moving On Evening'.

We are very much looking forward to this, our last term with the Year 4 and hope it will prove a most successful term for your child, with every individual continuing to make good progress academically, physically and socially.
