Dear Year 4 parents,

Happy New Year! We hope you had a fun and restful time over Christmas. It has been good to see the children again and we are looking forward to more hard work, fun and learning over the term ahead. It is great to look back and think about all we have covered and learnt since September, and we know you have been supporting your child in their learning, so thank you for that. On Wednesday afternoon, Miss Flynn will be teaching the class ICT covering PPA.

Details of the curriculum we will cover this term are attached with this letter, and are also available on our school website. The children will be taking part in the Lancaster Schools' Singing Festival at the Ashton Hall on 17th March. The children will be learning lots of songs in school and will have the chance to perform them in front of an audience.

P.E. will take place regularly throughout the week, please ensure that your child always has a complete, named indoor P.E. kit with black pumps in school every day and a swimming kit (if it is their turn to swim) on Thursdays. The children can also have an outdoor PE kit of leggings, a sweatshirt or hoodie and trainers for when we go outside.

For homework, your child will be expected to read regularly. They need to record this in their reading record. Please could you listen to your child read each week in order to support them in their understanding of the text. Please sign their record when you have done this, thank you. Your child will receive spellings each Monday to practise at home. Please return the spelling book each Monday. It is also essential that the children continue to learn their tables as they need to know them all (1-12) by the end of the year. There is a national test that the children will be taking in the Summer Term 2020.

There are parent and child consultations in March when you can discuss your child's progress but please do not hesitate to contact us before this if you feel it would be helpful, or have any queries or concerns at all.

We are very much enjoying teaching Year 4. It is great to see the progress they have already made since September. We are sure they will continue to progress over this coming term.
