

In English

We will be reading the story, 'Harry The Happy Mouse'. We will be looking at repetitive language, predicting the story and discussing the feelings of the characters. We will also look at some nursery rhymes looking at rhythm and rhyme. We will be learning how to form the letters in the alphabet. There will also be a daily phonic session and weekly S.P.A.G (spelling, punctuation and grammar) lessons. Your child will read independently or as part of a group during reading sessions with an adult.

In Maths

We will be following the 'White Rose' maths scheme. We will be focusing on numbers to 10, place value of a number, one more and one less, ordering and comparing numbers, addition and subtraction, and the different strategies we use to help work out the answer. **Regular counting from different number starters will benefit your child.**

In R.E.

This half term we will be looking at Harvest and the origins of food with Miss Flynn. **Please can you collect food labels from different countries and bring them into school next week.**

Key Vocabulary

Science- We will be looking at naming the external body parts. We will explore our 5 senses and identify the body parts associated with each sense.

Art- this half term we will look at different artists and their techniques. Keeping with the theme of 'Ourselves', we will look at self-portraits too where we will draw and paint. We will also look at using appropriate colours.

History- We will look at how people have changed through their lives by looking at baby pictures. **Please can you send a baby photo or email it to me. If you have a baby picture of yourself or a grandparent we can compare.**

PE- Our P.E days are Wednesday and Fridays. We will look at the Fundamental skills e.g. hopping, skipping, running, throwing, kicking etc through lots of games. We have begun to look at playground games to give them ideas of different games to play outside.

Computing- We will be learning how to log on with our own log in details and look at some of the skills involved in word processing. We will learn about technology around us, Online Safety and keeping safe online.

PSHE- We will be looking at 'Relationships' where this covers communicating their feelings to others and recognising different feelings.

This half term we will be trying out some different fruits and veg using the sense of taste. We will also have Intra-School sports where we will compete in our team colours.
