<u>English</u>

First, we will be reading A Bear Called Paddington. We will be learning about subordinate conjunctions and using them in our writing. We will finish the unit by writing our own chapter. We will then be reading and writing humorous poems about teachers and school life. We will learn about the use of powerful verbs, adverbs and prepositions to create impact. We will read I'll Take You to Mrs Cole and other stories by Michael Foreman and write a new version. We will learn about dialogue, verbs, and conjunctions for time, place and cause.

<u>Maths</u>

We will be working with numbers up to 1000 and making sure we have a secure understanding of the value of hundreds numbers. We will move on to calculating with two digits first and then three digit numbers. We will learn to use mental and written methods. After half term, we will be concentrating on written and mental multiplication and division. We will recap how to multiply and divide and the 2 and 5 times table. We will then moving on to learning the 3, 4 and 8 times table.

<u>R.E.</u>

Our first topic considers what it means to be 'Called by God' and after half term we will be reflecting upon Christmas including how 'God is with us' Autumn Term Stone Age to Iron Age & Volcanoes

<u>Science</u>

We start the term exploring rocks and soils. We will spend time naming and exploring rocks including investigating their properties before looking at different types of soil. After half term we move on to thinking about forces in terms of pushes and pulls, moving on to investigate magnetism as a force that does not require contact. We investigate which materials are magnetic and carry out several investigations including testing the strength of different magnets.

Art & DT

First we will be learning about the artist Eva Rothschild and her sculpture work. We will make our own sculptures in a similar style. After half term, we will be investigating packaging and how it is made for specific products. We will then design and make some packaging for an imaginary product.

<u>History</u>

We will be learning what life was like in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will look at the houses prehistoric people lived in, how they changed from hunter gatherers to farmers and will learn about Stonehenge.

Geography

We will be learning about volcanoes. We will use maps and atlases to find where some volcanoes are in the world and compare two volcanic areas. We will also explore the impact of eruptions on the environment.

PE

We start the year with a recap of the fundamental movement skills - running, hopping, skipping, jumping and rolling/bouncing/kicking/throwing a ball – before moving on to apply these skills in a variety of small team games.

Computing

First, we will be focusing on Online Safety and learning skills to be a safe and responsible digital citizen. After half term, we will be learning about email.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will focus on health and well-being this term including discussing what positively and negatively affects our physical, mental and emotional health.
