Whilst the children are at a stage where they can read independently, many of these books are particularly good to share with your child. This helps them hear good reading and expression being modelled and also allows for you to discuss any themes or vocabulary arising from the books. We have recently bought many of these books and so they are available in school if your child would like to borrow them.
