Sickness Policy

You are all no doubt aware that there have been a number of children off school due to sickness. Some of the children have vomited at home and then brought to school as they 'seem alright'. This is not acceptable, the policy is if a child is physically sick or has an episode of diarrhoea, they must be kept at home for a period of 48 hours following the last episode. If they should have a further episode during this time, then the 48 hours must start from that time. This is for the purposes of infection control as by following these guidelines the risk of spreading infection is dramatically reduced. Thank you for helping us to keep everyone healthy.

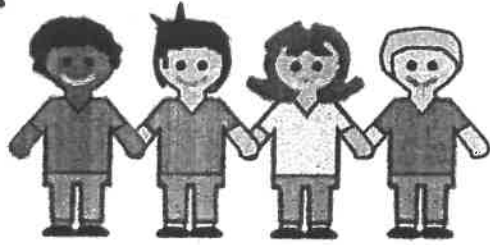
