We will be reading *The Owl and the Pussy-cat* by Edward Lear. We will explore the themes of the poem, write in role as the characters, create fictitious interviews, create lists of items they can take on their honeymoon and eventually innovate the poem to create their own versions. Following this, we will be looking at different versions of the story of *Goldilocks and the Three Bears*. We will begin with the traditional version and identify the elements of traditional tales. Another version will help us to see the story from Goldilocks' perspective so we can write a new version as told by her. We will then read a sequel to help us write our own.

Maths

We are currently finishing our work on mass and capacity. We will practically measure weight and capacity and use our calculation knowledge using units of measure. After this, we will learn to recognise fractions of shapes and numbers including $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ as well as non-unit fractions like $\frac{3}{4}$. We will then look at time and first learn to tell the time to the nearest 15 minutes before learning to tell time to 5 minutes.
