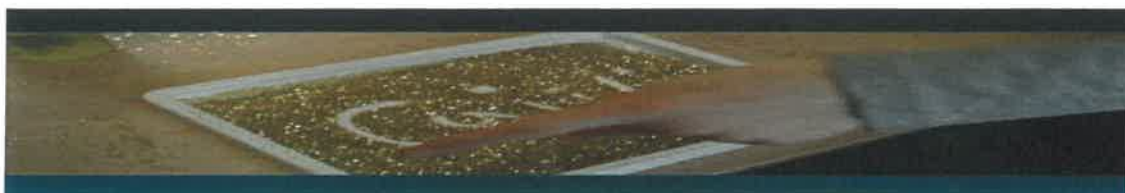
The deadline for applications for a primary place is 15th January 2020 and secondary place is 31st October 2019. Applications should be made online by visiting—

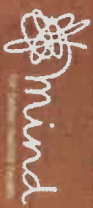
