Lost Property

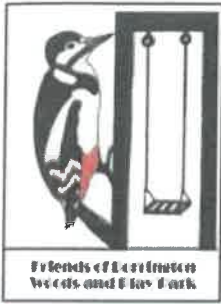
Today is your last chance to claim any lost property. Any unclaimed items will be disposed of over the summer holidays.

Uniform

Please see the information regarding our uniform policy in the School Prospectus. School accepts that towards the end of term shoes, trousers, skirts etc are getting a 'bit small' and you do not want to splash out on new uniform. However, at the start of next term school does expect every child to attend wearing the correct uniform. We appreciate that for some families this is a big outlay and therefore shirts and sweaters do not have to have the school logo, but must be the correct colours. Many of the supermarkets are doing fantastic deals on school uniform. Skirts and dresses should be of a reasonable length (it has been noted that some of the older children's skirt levels have become rather high). 'Tube' style skirts are not permitted, neither are trainers—even black ones! or long boots! Ankle boots, i.e. those that fit under trousers are permitted.
