Has anyone unwittingly picked up a rather smart blue lunch box which has several little compartments. Luke from Nursery has lost his—please have a look around your house. Many thanks.

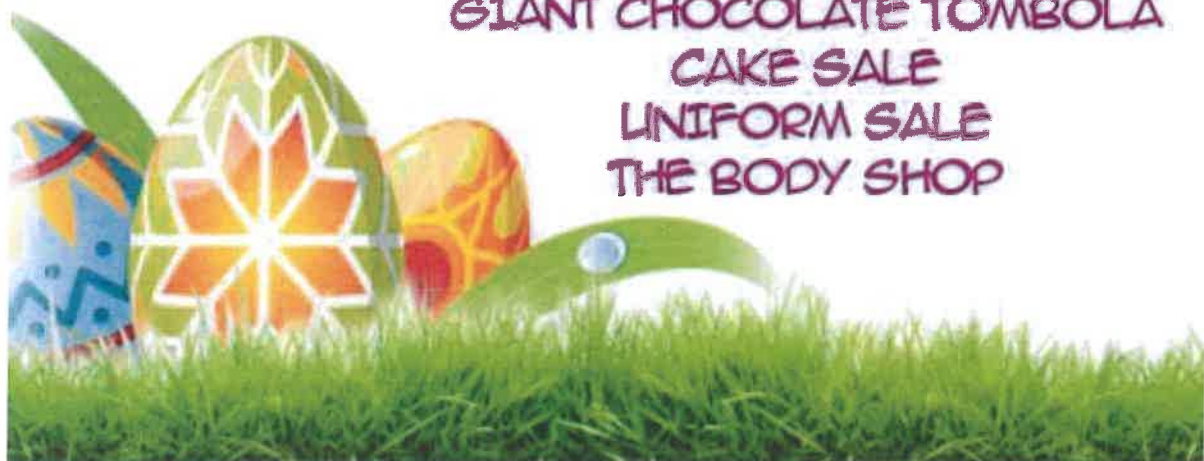

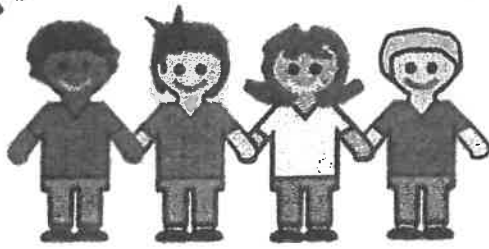
