# 'Superheroes'

## **Key Vocabulary**

<u>Science</u>- We will be looking at light, astronomy and space. We will also observe changes across the four seasons and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies and how the shadows can look different.

Art- We will print patterns and make our own printing press. Also we will design and make an alien using clay.

<u>Geography</u>- We will look at the globe and the weather around the world especially where extreme weather has taken place. We will discuss the changes/differences in our weather to around the world e.g. weather/seasons.

<u>History-</u> We will look at Neil Armstrong (the first moon landing) and a timeline of when that happened. We will also research into inventors/explorers – Who invented the lightbulb? Who made the first aeroplane? Who discovered America?

<u>PE-</u>Our P.E days are Mondays (Coach Steve for cricket), Wednesdays and Thursdays. We will continue to look at the Fundamental skills through dance and gymnastics.

<u>Computing-</u> We will continue to look at word processing, becoming more confident with typing and changing font style and size. We will also use technology to record the weather.

<u>PSHE-</u>We will be looking at 'Relationships,' where this covers communicating their feelings to others and recognising feelings within friendship groups. We will also recognise what is fair and unfair, kind and unkind, what is right and wrong. We will also discuss about change and loss and the associated feelings (including moving home, losing toys, pets or friends).

### **Wider Curriculum**

This half term we will have Intra-School sports where we will compete in our team colours.

We will also be having a 'Safer Internet Day' discussing how we can be safe when using the internet.

We will invite local 'Superheroes' e.g. Police, Firefighters and Ambulance in to see how they help us daily.
