

In English

In Literacy, we will be looking at writing a letter using 'Grandma Bird' story. We also look at Australian Folk Tales and compare stories. We will discuss our favourite and least favourite. Then move onto poetry on our theme, 'The Great Outdoors'. We will continue with daily phonic sessions, daily handwriting lessons and weekly S.P.A.G lessons. Your child will read in Independent/guided reading sessions with an adult weekly.

In Maths

This term, we will continue to focus on numbers to 100 where we will concentrate on the place value of numbers, addition and subtraction with 2-digit numbers and solving word problems. Continue working on daily counting up to 100 and learning number bonds to 20/100.

Super Speedy Maths: We will be continuing to count in multiples of 5s and 2s with money. Then to start telling the time to half an hour and $\frac{1}{4}$ an hour

In R.E.

This half term we will be looking at 'Joseph'.

Key Vocabulary

PE- Our P.E days are Wednesdays and Fridays. We will continue to look at the Fundamental skills through a series of games and athletics.

Computing- We will use imodel to create our own adventure game. We will also be looking at 'Paint' and its tools, to create our own Mondrian pieces.

PSHE- We will continue to discuss correct terminology for body parts, knowing that private parts are private, surprised and secrets and keeping safe e.g. road safety, sun safety and keeping our personal details safe.
