History- we will be discussing the difference between journeys on holidays now to journeys in the past. We look at seaside holidays in the past and explore the similarities and differences.

Art/DT- We will design and make a boat, evaluating the best materials and what would work and wouldn't. We will explore using water colour paints and use them on fabrics.

Geography- We will continue to be looking at maps/globes to find the UK, locating the 7 continents and naming the 5 oceans. We will be comparing hot and cold places looking at places in the UK and other parts of the World e.g. Australia. If you want to tell us about a country e.g. the foods, the climate, the language, currency, the houses etc. to allow the children to see what they are like, and then just let me know.

PE- Our P.E days are Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. We will continue to look at the Fundamental skills through a series of games and athletics.

Computing- We will continue to look at animation and sound. This will be taught by Mr Manning.

PSHE- We will be looking at 'Living in the Wider World' and how we can help look after the environment, whose responsibility it should be, about the role money plays in their lives including how to manage their money, keep it safe, choices about spending money and what influences those choices.
