We are starting to discourage children from drinking juice in their bottles. All bottles are now kept in the child's school bag to encourage them to drink more water/milk from the snack table.

We are really looking forward to working with your child this term. If you look at our blog on the school website you can have a look at some of the activities we have been doing in nursery. We have now set up a system where we can send observations of your child achieving an important milestone straight to your email address. Please make sure we have up to date contact details. We are also going to try sending a video clip but would only do this when there is only your own child in shot.
