Dear Parents and children,

Welcome to school or Welcome back!

This half term our topic is "Superheroes." We will be listening to stories about different superheroes and looking at how we can be super friends.

Each day we will be choosing our Nursery super tidiers/super listeners and super friends.

We are really looking forward to working with your child this spring term. If you look at our blog on the school website you can have a look at some of the activities we have been doing in nursery.

We will be going outside regularly. We have wellies the children can borrow but we may get dirty/wet so a spare change of clothes is handy.

Each day the children will come together in key worker groups to do phonics.

You are welcome to come into Nursery in a morning to drop your child off. The routine is that the child takes off their own coat and hangs up their bags. They then find their name and put it on the register tree before washing their hands.

We will continue to send observations home through the parent app "evidence me." You can also send me observations of your child at home. If your child is going to be off it is quicker to send a message via the school office.

From January 2022 we will continue to use the gate at the back of Nursery for dropping off and picking up. We will continue to have the windows open. If there is a confirmed case of covid in a child or adult at Nursery then we advise you to take your child for a PCR test. A positive case in Nursery will not shut Nursery to the other children. If your child tests positive then they must stay off. We will continue to send unwell children home and ask for your support in not sending children to Nursery if you feel they are unwell. We continue to follow government advice around handwashing.
