Year 3 learning this term....

In our science lessons, we will be venturing into the fascinating world of plants. The children will delve into the topic of plants, investigating various aspects such as growing conditions and the classification of different flowers. To enhance their learning experience, we will also be engaging in hands-on activities, where the children will have the opportunity to grow a range of plants.

Moving on to geography, our pupils will embark on a journey across Europe. In addition, we have planned local fieldwork excursions, aimed at connecting their classroom knowledge with real-world observations.
