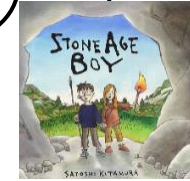
Well done to the library team who have raised over £200 towards new books for the school.



The new Nursery pupils have settled in really well. They have enjoyed finding out about each other and how they can eat healthy foods.

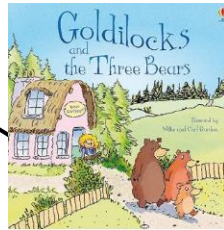


Pupils in Year 1 enjoyed their Wolf Day as an introduction to some English work.

Year 2 have been amazing scientists studying mini beasts and visiting Gentleshaw Park.

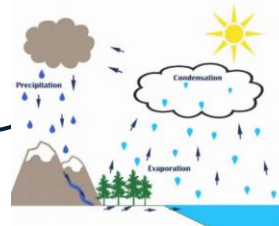


Year 5 have produced some super work that is literally out of this world . . . their 'space' theme took them on a trip to Jodrell Bank.
