

## Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2 2024 Year 4

Reading: 4D will be reading How to Train Your Dragon and 4T will be reading Friend or Foe. **Spellings:** We will continue to work through the spelling rules from EdShed. The children are working so hard each week to learn their spellings for the test each Friday. Times tables: The children will continue to own weekly focus for the times table test each week. We will also be having a big focus on getting ready for the Multiplication Check. It would be beneficial if the children could practice the Soundcheck on TT Rockstars as often as possible.

Homework: Spelling and Times tables.

**PE Kit:** Year 4 will need to come to school in their PE kit every Wednesday and Friday.



Our area of learning this term will be looking at the history and development of the railways and thinking about how this supported growth across the country and beyond.

Geography will focus on exploring mountains, looking at their formation, features and climates as well as thinking about what it's like to live in mountainous regions.

In Science we will be learning about electrical circuits and the different components. The unit is very hands on and allows the children to put their learning into a practical context. The end goal will link to our learning in DT where the children have to design and make a working light up sign.
