

Curriculum Newsletter Spring 2 2024 Year 4

Reading: We will be completing short style comprehension activities focusing on answering a range of questions using the Reader Roles. **Spellings:** We will continue to work through the spelling rules from EdShed. The children are working so hard each week to learn their spellings for the test each Friday. Times tables: As we are drawing nearer to the multiplication check in June, we are aiming for the children to be scoring at least 20 out of 25 on the Soundcheck on TTRS or Multiplication check. We strongly encourage those getting less than 20 to be completing daily practice at home, as regular practice does really make a difference.

Our area of learning this term will be continuing to look at the history and development of the railways and looking at the positive and negatives of the impacts of the railways and how technology has changed over time. We will then be moving on to learning about the Anglo-Saxon period. Geography will focus on comparing Snowdonia to the Dolomites, and looking at how different people live in mountainous regions.

In Science we will be learning about electrical circuits and the different components. The unit is very hands on and allows the children to put their learning into a practical context. The end goal will link to our learning in DT where the children have to design and make a working light up sign.
