INTENT

- Deliver a systematic synthetic phonics program, teaching letters and sounds in a structured way.
- Focus on building strong decoding skills to access a wider range of texts.
- Aim to develop confident and fluent readers by the end of Key Stage I.

IMPLEMENTATION

- Deliver the Rocket Phonics scheme with dedicated lesson plans and materials.
- Daily phonics lessons incorporating activities of sound discrimination, blending and segmenting.
- Follow the embedded lesson cycle which incorporates recall; activating prior learning, explicit teaching, modelled practice, individual practice, and assessment and feedback.
- Use the scheme's engaging and multi-sensory approaches to support learning.
- Match Rocket Phonics reading books and online books as target practice readers and at individual's assessed reading ability.
- Assess regularly to identify individual needs and provide targeted support.

IMPACT

- Observable improvement in children's phonics knowledge and reading fluency.
- · Positive impact on children's spelling abilities.
- Increased confidence in reading across different text types.
- Individual pathways to benefit children with diverse learning needs.
